

## Huntington-Surrey Phase Management Covid-19 Response

Huntington Surrey is committed to the safety of our school community and has adopted a planning approach that follows governmental agency directives as well as the guidelines and recommendations from the CDC and the Austin-Travis County Health Authority Public.

While it is not possible for Huntington Surrey to provide zero risk of contracting Covid-19, we will strive to manage the inherent health risks.

In order to have an on-campus, in-person school experience, students, staff, and parents are required to modify their behavior and interactions and abide by protocols outlined by our phased operations.

Risk levels are those designated by Travis County for "Covid-19 Community Level."

<b>MEDIUM</b>	Temperature check at beginning when student arrives to school; screening questions	Mandatory student-provided masks; hand sanitizers available; physical distancing encouraged; HEPA filtering units in classrooms 11, 13, 15, 17; wipe tables between classes.	Physical distancing and outdoor dining encouraged; no student use of kitchen at lunch; no microwave available (to discourage congregating near microwave).	Physical distancing	Eligible seniors may leave campus at lunch.  Arrive late/leave early if first or last period study hall.  Only one person at a time is permitted in the student restrooms.
<b>HIGH</b>	Temperature check at beginning when student arrives to school; screening questions	Mandatory student-provided masks; hand sanitizers available; physical distancing encouraged; HEPA filtering units in classrooms 11, 13, 15, 17; wipe tables between classes	Physical distancing and outdoor dining encouraged; no student use of kitchen at lunch. .	Physical distancing	All students must remain on campus for lunch.  Arrive late/leave early if first or last period study hall.  Only one person at a time is permitted in the student restrooms.
