GENERAL SUPPLIES

- Backpack to carry books and supplies during the day
- Reusable water bottle
- Hand sanitizer
- Package of masks to keep in your locker
- Laptop, tablet, Surface, or Chromebook **with charger** (suggested: spare charger to keep in locker)
- Planner
- Dividers and notebook paper for each binder
- Pencils
- Pens

- Optional: a flash drive

CLASS SPECIFIC SUPPLIES

Some special supplies for electives and projects in core classes may be needed throughout the school year. You will be notified by the teacher in advance if additional materials will be needed.

1-1 LITERATURE (grades 9, 10, 11)

- One Composition book (bound)
- Student may need to purchase a paperback copy of specific books for 1-1 literature (they will annotate their book); students will select books with their lit teachers after school starts

ENGLISH COMPOSITION (all grades)

- Blue 3-ring binder (1.5" or 2")
- Colored pens for editing/proofing (red, blue, and one either green or purple)
- Composition book (separate from the one for Lit - blue is preferred for English Comp)

MATH (all grades)

- White 3-ring binder (1.5" to 2")
- *Algebra I and Algebra II Students*: scientific calculator (Suggested TI-30Xa)
- *Geometry/Precalculus/Calculus Students*:
 - graph paper
 - graphing calculator

SCIENCE (all grades)

- Green 3-ring binder(1.5" or 2") with 3 pocket dividers
- Spiral notebook with 3-holes punched to fit in binder (green is preferred for science)
- Zipper pouch for binder (to hold pencil, pen, calculator, and "clicker" supplied by teacher)
- Scientific Calculator Suggested Scientific Calculator: TI-30Xa, about \$10 to \$12

SOCIAL STUDIES (all grades)

- Red 3-ring binder(1.5" or 2") with three pocket dividers
- *World Geography*: colored pencils

LANGUAGES OTHER THAN ENGLISH (all grades)

Latin: binder (any color not already used)

Spanish: binder (any color not already used) and a manila folder, physical copy of a Spanish-English dictionary

ART I and Art II

- 1-2 fine point permanent markers (for example: sharpie ultra fine)
- 2 or more black or blue ball point pens (recommended: Uniball Signo)
- Set of drawing pencils containing at least 6 pencils ranging from 6B to 4H (for example: 6B, 4B, 2B, HB, 2H, 4H)
- 1 spiral bound sketchbook, at least 7" by 10", with 60 pages minimum of mixed media (98lb) paper or drawing (64-68lb) paper

FABRIC ARTS

- Scissors suitable for fabric (Fisker, Singer, etc.)
- Seam ripper
- Glass head pins (fine or extra fine)
- 3-ring binder (any color not used in another class)
- Dividers
- Post-its (med. ruled)

YEARBOOK:

- A working laptop (not tablet) that is NOT a chromebook.
